## CITY OF DEER PARK, OHIO RESOLUTION NO. 2022-08

## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO THE CITY OF DEER PARK – SYCAMORE TOWNSHIP JOINT ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT INCOME TAX COLLECTION AND DISTRIBUTION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Deer Park, Ohio and Sycamore Township contracted to create the City of Deer Park – Sycamore Township Joint Economic Development District ("District") to facilitate economic development and redevelopment, to create and to preserve jobs and employment opportunities, and to improve the economic welfare of the people in Deer Park and in Sycamore Township, all within Hamilton County. Ohio and the District's area; and

WHEREAS, the Contract was entered into under R.C. 715.72 and other applicable provisions of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, under the Contract, the District Board of Directors has adopted a resolution to levy an income tax within the District in accordance with R.C. 715.72(F) and Section 10 of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary under R.C. 715.72(F) for the District Board of Directors to enter into an agreement with Deer Park to administer, collect, and enforce the income tax on behalf of the District ("Agreement").

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Council of the City of Deer Park, a majority of members concurring:

**SECTION I:** City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into the Agreement so that the City can administer, collect, and enforce the income tax on behalf of the District as provided in such Agreement and Ohio law.

SECTION II: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage
