

## **Minutes of the Sycamore Township Special Events Committee Meeting September 27, 2022**

The meeting was called to order at 7:20 p.m.

Present for the meeting were Chairman Jason Petty, Lisa Bass Hodge, Megan Dollenmeyer, and Brent Grunow. Holly Talmage and Joe Mueller were absent.

### **Review of Past Meeting Minutes**

Mr. Petty asked the committee to review the minutes from the August 22, 2022 meeting. After review, Mrs. Hodge made a motion to accept the August 22, 2022 meeting minutes, Mr. Grunow seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

### **Pollinator Event**

The committee briefly discussed what the event would entail. Mr. Petty suggested that the event be a seminar with speakers over a three-hour period. Lisa Hodge suggested having refreshments for an event that long. Mr. Petty told the committee that he would contact various groups about presenting for the event.

### **Recap/Evaluation of 2022 Concert & Movies**

Mr. Petty informed the committee that there were three families at the September movie in the park event with a total of twelve people. The committee discussed the low attendance of the movies in the park events. After the discussion Lisa Hodge made a motion to cancel the movie in the park events, Brent Grunow seconded the motion, the motion passed unanimously.

The committee discussed the concerts in the park events, the committee felt that the attendance at the concerts was much better than the movies. Mr. Petty suggested limiting the concert series to June, July, and August because of the low attendance in September.

### **Discussion of future events**

During the agenda topic of concerts and movies, Mr. Grunow introduced the idea of bringing back the Festival in Sycamore as an event. After discussion, Mr. Grunow made a motion to move forward with the Festival in Sycamore, Mrs. Hodge seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. The committee decided to continue with the concerts in the park for the months of June, July, and August. Mrs. Hodge made a motion to continue the concerts in the park, Mrs. Dollenmeyer seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
