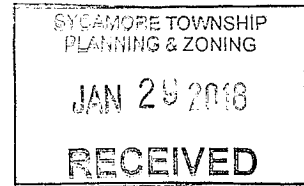

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

This is to serve as my official request to be placed on the agenda for your next regularly scheduled public meeting in February, 2018.

Sycamore Township, Ohio, their agent(s), et al, have filed multiple Sycamore Township, Ohio, Zoning Code Violations against me over the years, most recently in 2017.

According to The Sycamore Township, Ohio, internet web site, www.sycamoretownship.org; Link: Zoning; Board of Zoning Appeals-- prior to 2017, during 2017, and as of today's date in 2018, ALL zoning code violations since 2013, are to be first presented and reviewed by The Sycamore Township, Ohio, Board of Zoning Appeals, prior to the issuance of zoning code violation citations, and pursuit of legal action in a court of law, against anyone through a legal court of law process.

I have not been granted ANY “due process of law” on these pending legal issues.


