



GENERAL PLANTING NOTES:

A. Do not prune tree at planting except to: Remove crossover limbs, co-dominant leaders, and broken or dead branches.

B. Mark the north side of tree in nursery. Rotate mark on tree to face north at site.

C. Cut wire basket, burlap and rope in four places and fold down 8" into planting pit.

D. The root ball shall rest on unexcavated and or natural subgrade.

E. All tree pits shall receive 3 fertilizer tablets equally spaced within the top 12" of planting soil mixture.

F. Tamp backfill mixture around root ball base firmly with foot pressure to prevent shifting of the tree.

G. Trunk flare shall be visible at completion of planting or tree will be rejected. Do not cover the top of the root ball with soil.

H. Wrap tree trunks only upon the approval of the Landscape Architect.


- 1. All work shall be done in accordance with the Landscape Planting Plan, L1 and L2 prepared by The LandPlan Group, L.L.C.
- 2. The Landscape Contractor shall secure all necessary permits and approvals from agencies governing the landscape work prior to beginning any work.
- 3. The Landscape Contractor is responsible for keeping the premises and adjacent construction equipment clean and free of dirt and debris.
- 4. The Landscape Contractor shall field verify all existing utility line locations prior to any construction. Any deviations from the design locations shall be reported to The LandPlan Group, L.L.C. at (260) 422-2522 prior to relocation. The Landscape Contractor is responsible for repairing any and all damage to utilities and structures which occur as a result of the landscape construction.
- 5. The Landscape Contractor is responsible for coordinating and scheduling all landscape related work with other contractors and trades.
- 6. The Landscape Contractor shall notify The LandPlan Group, L.L.C. immediately if any discrepancies in the construction documents are found.
- 7. The Landscape Contractor is responsible for providing and spreading 4" of approved topsoil in all lawn areas. Topsoil is available on site. The Landscape Contractor is responsible for performing all finish grading in conjunction with seeding the site. Topsoil addition is not required by the Landscape Contractor. The Landscape Contractor shall ensure that the finish grade of all lawn and planting areas is flush with the adjacent hardscape elements (such as curbs and walks).
- 8. The Landscape Contractor is responsible for providing and installing approved planting soil mix in the following areas per the planting details.

 1) Tree Planting Pits 2) Shrub Planting Pits 3) Groundcovers 4) Perennials & Annuals
- 9. The Landscape Contractor shall inspect all backfill and placement of topsoil to determine whether or not a "Hardpan" situation exists or could exist due to previous soil conditions, placement of and compaction of fill during construction, or any other contributing factor prior to installation of plant materials. If such a situation is found or anticipated, it should be brought to the attention of The LandPlan Group, L.L.C. and/or Owner immediately, and prior to the installation of plant material, for a remedy. The Landscape Contractor is responsible for plant replacement if plant material is planted in a "Hardpan" situation.
- 10. Herbicide (Treflan or equivalent) shall be applied to all plant beds prior to planting for noxious weed control.
- 11. All planting beds shall have a minimum of 3" thick processed shredded hardwood mulch. All planting bed edges shall be a 3-4" deep natural spade or machine trenched edge.
- 12. All trees shall be straight trunked, full-headed and staked per the planting details.
- 13. Dimensions for heights, spread and caliper of trees specified on the Plant List are general guides for the minimum desired size of each plant. Each plant shall have a uniform and consistent shape as it pertains to the latest edition of American Standard for Nursery Stock. Any plant material which fails to conform to the specifications is subject to rejection by Owner/The LandPlan Group, L.L.C.
- 14. The quantities indicated on the Plant List are provided for the benefit of the Landscape Contractor, but should not be assumed to always be correct. In the event of a discrepancy, the Planting Plans will take precedence over the Plant List. The Landscape Contractor shall be responsible for quantities, calculations and the liability pertaining to those quantities and any related contract documents and/or price quotations.
- 15. The Landscape Contractor is responsible for seeding all lawn areas indicated on the Landscape Planting Plans. Refer to the mixture and application rate below:
- Seed Mix: (or Approved Equal)
 1) 30% Chateau Kentucky Bluegrass
- 2) 30% Nassau Kentucky Bluegrass
- 3) 15% Glade Kentucky Bluegrass
- 4) 15% Pebble Beach Perennial Rye 5) 10% Competitor Perennial Rye
- Application Rate: 4-5 Lbs./1,000 S.F.
- 16. The Landscape Contractor is responsible for providing positive drainage out of all planting islands and planting strips between hardscape elements (such as curbs and walks).
- 17. Seed shall be spread in two successive sowings with the second perpendicular to the first. Seeded areas shall be uniformly mulched with straw or hay. Contractor has the option to include mulch in hydroseed applications (where applicable). A satisfactory mulch stand of 85% coverage shall be established.
- 18. Upon locating sources for plant material and before purchase and delivery, the Landscape Contractor shall arrange an inspection visit with The LandPlan Group, L.L.C. at the Landscape Architect's discretion in order to make all plant materials meet specifications.
- 19. The Landscape Contractor shall completely guarantee all plant material for the period of one (1) full year beginning at the date of total acceptance by the Owner/The LandPlan Group, L.L.C. The Landscape Contractor shall promptly make all replacements before or at the end of the guarantee period as the growing season permits.
- 20. All staking and guying to be removed by Landscape Contractor immediately following end of guarantee period.
- 21. Landscape Boulders shall vary in size from a minimum of 2'x2' to a maximum of 4'x4'. Bury the bottom $\frac{1}{3}$ of each boulder below grade. Allow for 8 to 10 boulders.

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
IRRIGATION NOTE:


ORNAMENTAL GRASS PLANTING DETAIL


