RESOLUTION NO. 1981-38

PROHIBITION AGAINST PARKING COMMERCIAL AND HEAVY VEHICLES, TRAILERS & BOATS

WHERCAS, the Sycamore Township Board of Trustees is authorized by Ohio Revised Code \$505.17 to require vehicle parking as necessary within the unincorporated areas of the township, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to regulate commercial and heavy vehicle, trailer and boat parking in residential unincorporated areas of the township,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sycamore Township:

Section 1. That "Commercial Tractor" shall mean every motor vehicle having motor power designed or used for drawing other vehicles and not so constructed as to carry any load while carrying a portion of such other vehicles, or the load thereon, or both.

Section 2. That "Semi-Trailer" shall mean every vehicle designed or used for carrying persons or property with another and separate motor vehicle so that in operation a part of its own weight or that of its load, or both, rests upon and is carried by another vehicle.

Section 3. That "Trailer" shall mean every vehicle designed or used for carrying persons or property wholly on its own structure and for being drawn by a motor vehicle, including any such vehicle when formed by or operated as a combination of a semi-trailer and a vehicle of the dolly type, such as that commonly known as a "trailer dolly". "Trailer" shall also mean all house vehicles.

Section 4. That "Truck" shall mean every motor vehicle, except trailers and semi-trailers, designed and used to carry property, except pick-up trucks not being used for commercial purposes.

Section 5. That "Boat" shall mean every vehicle design or used for carrying persons or property upon water.

Section 6. That no person shall stop, park, or leave standing on any street in the township, except state or county roads, any vehicle exceeding a gross weight of five tons, or a commercial tractor, or truck, or trailer, or semitrailer or boat except when such parking is necessary to load or unload property, to perform other business services requiring the parking of such vehicle, to comply with the provisions of the Ohio Traffic Code (Chapter 4511), or to obey the directions of a police officer or a traffic control device. Vehicles parked fo loading or unloading or to perform other business services on or along public roads must be connected to a towing vehicle at all times. Operators of vehicles so parked within the unincorporated area of the township shall limit such parking to a reasonable period of time to perform the loading or unloading or other business service.

Section 7. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
