RESOLUTION NO. 2018 - 61

**A RESOLUTION ALLOCATING ONE PERCENT (1%) OF ALL REVENUE
GENERATED BY THE SYCAMORE TOWNSHIP EXCISE LODGING TAX TO BE
USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF ROAD MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, AND PAVING AND
DISPENSING WITH A SECOND READING**

WHEREAS, pursuant to O.R.C. §5739.08, Sycamore Township currently imposes a three percent (3%) excise lodging tax; and

WHEREAS, all revenue collected from the excise lodging tax is deposited into the Township's general fund; and

WHEREAS, funds from the Township general fund can be used for road maintenance, repair, and paving of township roads; and

WHEREAS, the board of Township Trustees is desirous of protecting the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The Board hereby orders that one percent of all revenue generated by the Sycamore Township excise lodging tax as set forth in O.R.C. §5739.08 is to be used for the purposes of road maintenance, repair, and the paving of township roads.

SECTION 2. The Board, by at least a majority vote, hereby dispenses with any requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.




