**RESOLUTION NO. 2009-154**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE KIRTLEY DRIVE LIGHTING DISTRICT,  
DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 515, a petition for a lighting district was filed with the Township Fiscal Officer for Kirtley Drive; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 6, 2009 the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township established the Kirtley Drive Lighting District which imposed an assessment of \$7.00 per year per lot for ten years; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 17, 2009, the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township received an additional petition requesting that two additional streetlights be added to the Kirtley Drive Lighting District; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 515.09, the Board desires to add two additional lights to the district at a cost per lot of \$7.00 per light per lot, per year for a period of ten (10) years;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, Hamilton County, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** The Kirtley Drive Lighting District which includes the following street: Kirtley Drive, is hereby amended to add two additional lights.

**SECTION 2.** The costs of such lighting district shall be assessed against each parcel of real estate fronting on such street in an equal amount per parcel for each parcel bounding and abutting upon the street so lighted at a rate of \$7.00 per light per lot per year, for a total of \$21.00 per lot per year which amount includes the amounts for the original assessment.

**SECTION 3.** The assessment for such lighting shall be paid in twenty equal semi-annual installments and shall be paid and collected in the same manner in which real estate taxes are paid and collected.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.

**SECTION 5.** By at least three fourths vote of the members of the Board, the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days is hereby waived.


**SECTION 6.**


