# A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING RATES OF PAY FOR TOWNSHIP EMPLOYEES, DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Board of Township Trustees wishes to establish a new rate of pay for township employees that have completed or are completing their probationary periods:

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** 

Effective with the pay period beginning May 3, 2010, the following employee shall be compensated at the amount set opposite his name:

Mark Singer

\$51,285.60/year

Mark Singer shall be entitled to other township benefits in accordance with the contract between International Association of Fire Fighters Local 3907 and Sycamore Township.

**SECTION 2.** 

Effective with the pay period beginning May 17, 2010, the following employee shall be compensated at the amount set opposite his name:

Michael Kramer

\$51,285.60/year

Michael Kramer shall be entitled to other township benefits in accordance with the contract between International Association of Fire Fighters Local 3907 and Sycamore Township.

**SECTION 3.** 

Effective with the pay period beginning May 17, 2010, the following employee shall be compensated at the amount set opposite his name:

Michael McKeown

\$55,000.00/year

Michael McKeown shall be entitled to other township benefits in accordance with the Sycamore Township Employee Manual.

**SECTION 4.** 

The portions of Section 3 of Resolution 2009-170, which read as follows:

"Kramer

43,481.58/year"...

"Singer

43481.58/year"

are deleted in their entirety as those rates reflect the probationary period rates of pay for the affected employees.

#### **SECTION 5.**

The portion of Section 2 of Resolution 2009-170, which reads as follows:

"McKeown

47,500/year"

is deleted in its entirety as that rates reflects the prior rate of pay for the affected employee.

#### SECTION 6.

The Trustees of Sycamore Township upon majority vote do hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days, and hereby authorize the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

#### **SECTION 7.**

Upon the unanimous vote of the Sycamore Township Trustees, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare of Sycamore Township. The reason for the emergency is to provide wages and benefits in a timely manner to Township employees.
