RESOLUTION NO. 2010- 71

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE HARRISON AVENUE LIGHTING DISTRICT  
AND DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING**

WHEREAS, the Harrison Avenue Lighting District will expire on December 31, 2010; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on continuing the lighting district was held on October 7, 2010, the required notice having first been given,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, Hamilton County, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** The Harrison Avenue Lighting District shall be extended and continued for an additional ten years which district shall include the following street: Harrison Avenue between Pine Street and St. Clair Avenue.

**SECTION 2.** The costs of such lighting district shall be assessed against each parcel of real estate fronting on such streets at \$.25 per front foot for each parcel bounding and abutting upon the streets so lighted.

**SECTION 3.** The assessment for such lighting shall be paid in ten equal annual installments and shall be paid and collected in the same manner in which taxes are paid and collected.


**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.






