Harrison Avenue between Pine Street and St. Clair Avenue.

The costs of such lighting district shall be assessed against each parcel of real estate fronting on such streets at \$.25 per front foot for each parcel bounding and abutting upon the streets so lighted.

SECTION 3. The assessment for such lighting shall be paid in ten equal annual installments and shall be paid and collected in the same manner in which taxes are paid and collected.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.

SECTION 5. The requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days is hereby waived.
