RESOLUTION NO. 2012- 09

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE HEMESATH DRIVE LIGHTING DISTRICT
AND DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING**

WHEREAS, a petition was received in the office of the Fiscal Officer of Sycamore Township petitioning the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township to establish the Hemesath Drive Lighting District in Sycamore Township; and

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of January, 2012, the Board of Township Trustees were given notice of the filing of the petition to establish the Hemesath Drive Lighting District; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on continuing the lighting district was held on February 16, 2012, the required notice having first been given;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, Hamilton County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The Hemesath Drive Lighting District is hereby established for ten years which district shall include the following street: Hemesath Drive.

SECTION 2. The costs of such lighting district shall be assessed against each parcel of real estate fronting on such streets at \$39.86 per lot per year for each parcel bounding and abutting upon Hemesath Drive.

SECTION 3. The assessment for such lighting shall be paid in ten equal annual installments and shall be paid and collected in the same manner in which taxes are paid and collected.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.

SECTION 5. Any requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days is hereby waived.


