**RESOLUTION NO. 2012 - 18**

**A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE RICHMOND AVENUE LIGHTING DISTRICT  
AND DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 515, the Richmond Avenue Lighting District was established which includes the following street: Richmond Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, the Richmond Avenue Lighting District will expire at the end of 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Township Trustees desires to renew the Richmond Avenue Lighting District; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing on the proposed lighting district renewal was held on April 19, 2012, all required notices having first been given,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** The Richmond Avenue Lighting District shall be extended and continued for an additional ten years which district shall include the following street: Richmond Avenue.

**SECTION 2.** The costs of such lighting district shall be assessed against each parcel of real estate fronting on such street in the amount of \$16.59 per parcel per year for each parcel bounding and abutting upon the street so lighted.

**SECTION 3.** The assessment for such lighting shall be paid in ten equal annual installments and shall be paid and collected in the same manner in which taxes are paid and collected.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.

**SECTION 5.** Any requirements that this Resolution be read on two separate days is hereby waived and the Board authorizes its approval upon the first reading.




