RESOLUTION 2014 - 2a

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING NO PARKING ON AN AREA OF WEXFORD AVENUE IN SYCAMORE TOWNSHIP, DISPENSING WITH SECOND READING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, in order to provide for safe streets and roads in Sycamore Township, Ohio;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1.

Due to indiscriminate parking and to insure the free movement of emergency vehicles on Wexford Avenue, a dedicated road in Sycamore Township, there shall be no parking on the west side of Wexford Avenue from the intersection of Wexford Avenue and Mantell Avenue extending south a distance of 320 feet.

SECTION 2.

The Township Maintenance Department shall install the appropriate signage as required by law to enforce this Resolution.

SECTION 3.

The Trustees of Sycamore Township upon at least a majority vote do hereby dispense with any requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days, and hereby authorize the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

SECTION 4.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

SECTION 5.

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health, and welfare of the Township. The reason for the emergency is to provide for safe streets and roads in Sycamore Township and to allow the free movement of emergency vehicles.
