RESOLUTION NO. 2015 - 42

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A MAJOR ADJUSTMENT TO A SITE PLAN FOR AN APPROVED PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT FOR THE BROOKDALE PLACE DEVELOPMENT AND DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING

WHEREAS, application was made by Ranjit Sharma of CCH Services on behalf of Brookdale Place at Kenwood, LLC, the owners (the "Applicant") for a major adjustment to a planned unit development now known as the Brookdale Place at Kenwood Development (formerly the Karrington Communities Development) for additional parking in the development in Case Number 2015-05MA; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2015, after proper notice having been given, the Sycamore Township Zoning Commission held a public hearing to consider the application for approval of a major adjustment for the Brookdale Place at Kenwood Development in Case Number 2015-05MA; and

WHEREAS, the real property in Case No. 2015-05MA, consists of the real property located at 9090 Montgomery Road, in Sycamore Township, and is designated as Hamilton County Auditor's Parcel Number 600-0050-0046-00; (the "Real Property");

WHEREAS, the Real Property is located in the "OO"- Office District with a Planned Unit Development (PUD) overlay; and

WHEREAS, because the proposed use of the property is a major adjustment to a previously approved PUD plan, which has been previously approved and amended in Sycamore Township Zoning Case Number 1-96 (Hamilton County) it is necessary that the development receive a site plan approval as a major adjustment; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2015, in a public hearing and an open meeting, the Sycamore Township Zoning Commission recommended approval of the development with certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, on April 2, 2015, after proper notice having been given, the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township held a public hearing to consider the application for site plan approval;

NOW THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1.

The Application of Ranjit Sharma of CCH Services on behalf of Brookdale Place at Kenwood, LLC, the owners, for additional parking in the Planned Unit Development in Case No. 2015-05MA is hereby approved. This approval is subject to the Real Property being in compliance with all of the conditions contained within this Resolution including those conditions set forth on the Exhibit A attached hereto.

SECTION 2.

All other approvals, conditions, obligations and requirements contained in previous approval of the Planned Unit Development as amended in prior resolutions of the Board of Township Trustees and not adjusted herein shall remain in full force and affect.

SECTION 3.

Any use and improvements made to the Real Property which is the subject of this Resolution shall be made and constructed in compliance with the plans, specifications, and renderings submitted to the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township at the public hearing on April 2, 2015 and approved by this Resolution, including any conditions contained on the Exhibit A attached hereto, and any previous resolutions in effect that affect the Real Property that are not amended herein.

SECTION 4.

No Zoning Certificate shall be issued by the Zoning Administrator until:

- A) a Zoning Compliance Plan in compliance with this Resolution has been received and approved by the Zoning Administrator;
- B) all documents submitted for zoning certificates are fully coordinated and consistent with the approved Zoning Compliance Plan:

No building permit for actual construction shall be issued by the Hamilton County Building Commissioner before a Zoning Certificate is received from the Zoning Administrator.

No Final Zoning Certificate shall be issued by the Zoning Administrator until the development complies with all requirements contained in this Resolution and the Zoning Compliance Plan and, unless waived by the Zoning Administrator, the following documents are received and approved by the Zoning Administrator:

- a summary report from Hamilton County Engineer A) certifying that the approved plans and specifications for roadway and access improvements, either on-site or offsite, have been completely implemented, and that any required rights-of-way have been dedicated;
- a summary report from the developer's registered B) engineer or surveyor as required by and addressed to the Hamilton County Director of Public Works Department certifying that the approved plans and specifications for storm drainage improvements have been completely implemented; the Director of Public Works shall inform the Zoning Administrator when such letter is received and approved;
- a summary report from the Metropolitan Sewer District C) or Hamilton County Board of Health certifying that the approved plans and specifications for sanitary sewer and

- waste water treatment have been completely implemented;
- D) a summary report from the registered landscape architect who prepared the plan, certifying completion of the landscape plan, and soil erosion and sedimentation control measures as specified on the approved plan and noting any deviations and the reasons for such deviations;
- E) a summary report from the Sycamore Township Fire Chief certifying that the approved plan and specifications for fire prevention and control have been completely implemented, and
- F) a summary report from the applicant's registered engineer, surveyor or attorney certifying that required easements for access, utilities, or other purposes have been recorded in the Office of the Hamilton County Recorder.

SECTION 6.

All aspects of the development of the Real Property including, but not limited to, drainage, property improvements, lighting, landscaping, and ground cover, as set forth in the plans, specifications, covenants, conditions, requirements and limitations of the Zoning Compliance Plan and contained in this Resolution shall be continually maintained by the owner of the property. Any failure to so maintain the development shall be considered a violation of the Sycamore Township Zoning Resolution and shall be subject to all penalties and remedies thereunder.

SECTION 7.

The Trustees of Sycamore Township upon at least a majority vote do hereby dispense with any requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, and hereby authorize the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.

EXHIBIT A

Conditions of Approval:

- 1. All interior landscaping shall be approved by Township zoning staff and at a minimum shall comply with Section 12 of the Sycamore Township Zoning Resolution. Staff shall issue such landscaping of the landscaping only upon a showing that the real property to the north of the development shall be screened from the parking lot.
- 2. The dumpster surround shall be constructed of brick or stone as required by the Sycamore Township Zoning Resolution.
- 3. Parking spaces shall be constructed, paved and striped as shown on the submitted site plan/survey and shall be not less than 9'by 18'.
- 4. The Applicant/Owners shall comply with all requirements of the Hamilton County Public Works Department for storm water control.
