RESOLUTION 2022 - 095

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING AND REPLACING IN ITS ENTIRETY,
RESOLUTION 2021-78. RENEWING AND UPGRADING TO LED LIGHTS THE
RICHMOND AVENUE LIGHTING DISTRICT AND DISPENSING
WITH A SECOND READING**

WHEREAS, the Richmond Avenue Lighting District will expire on December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 515, the Board of Township Trustees desires to continue the Richmond Avenue Lighting District upon expiration of the contracts for the lighting district; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on continuing the lighting district was held on September 20, 2022, the required notice having first been given,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, Hamilton County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The Richmond Avenue Lighting District shall be extended, upgraded to LED lights and continued for an additional ten years which district shall include the following street: Richmond Avenue.

SECTION 2. The costs of such lighting district shall be assessed against each parcel of real estate fronting on such street at \$14.21 per parcel per year bounding and abutting upon the street so lighted.

SECTION 3. The assessment for such lighting shall be paid in ten equal annual installments and shall be paid and collected in the same manner in which taxes are paid and collected.


SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
