**RESOLUTION 2022 - 096**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING AND REPLACING IN ITS ENTIRITY,  
RESOLUTION 2021-79. RENEWING AND UPGRADING TO LED LIGHTS THE  
HEMESATH DRIVE LIGHTING DISTRICT AND DISPENSING  
WITH A SECOND READING**

**WHEREAS**, the Hemesath Drive Lighting District will expire on December 31, 2022;  
and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 515, the Board of Township Trustees desires to continue the Hemesath Drive Lighting District upon expiration of the contracts for the lighting district; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing on continuing the lighting district was held on September 20, 2022, the required notice having first been given,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, Hamilton County, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** The Hemesath Drive Lighting District shall be extended, upgraded to LED lights and continued for an additional ten years which district shall include the following street: Hemesath Drive.

**SECTION 2.** The costs of such lighting district shall be assessed against each parcel of real estate fronting on such street at \$16.85 per parcel per year bounding and abutting upon the street so lighted.

**SECTION 3.** The assessment for such lighting shall be paid in ten equal annual installments and shall be paid and collected in the same manner in which taxes are paid and collected.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.

**SECTION 5.** The requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days is hereby waived.




