# A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO APPROVE A CONTRACT FOR PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURANCE, DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Township Trustees wishes to continue to maintain property and casualty insurance for the protection of Township assets;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The Board hereby authorizes the Township Administrator to approve a

contract with The Ohio Plan for the provision of property and casualty

insurance for a premium in an amount not to exceed \$144,222.00.

**SECTION 2.** The Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, by at least two-

third vote of all of its members, dispenses with any requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and authorizes its passage upon

one reading.

**SECTION 3.** Upon the unanimous vote of the Sycamore Township Trustees, this

Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of Sycamore Township and shall take effect immediately. The reason for the emergency is to provide for property and casualty insurance for Sycamore

Township.
