RESOLUTION 2008- 88

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT FOR THE KENWOOD WALL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT, DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Board of Township Trustees is desirous of making improvements to the retaining walls on Kenwood Road in the in the Township (the "Kenwood Road Wall Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Township caused plans and specifications for the Kenwood Road Wall Project to be prepared and advertised for bids as required by state law; and

WHEREAS, Lithco Restoration Technologies LLC submitted the lowest and best bid for the Kenwood Road Wall Project in the amount of \$46,100.00;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The President of the Board and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to contract with Lithco Restoration Technologies LLC to provide for the Kenwood Road Wall Project as set forth in the plans and specifications prepared by the Township for the project.

SECTION 2. The contract with Lithco Restoration Technologies LLC shall provide that the contractor shall provide and furnish all of the labor, materials, tools, expendable equipment, and all utility, insurance and transportation services required in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the Township for the Kenwood Road Wall Project, which plans and specifications shall be made a part of such contract.

SECTION 3. Subject to additions and deletions contained therein, the contract price with Lithco Restoration Technologies LLC shall not exceed \$46,100.00.

SECTION 4. The Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, by at least two-third vote of all of its members, dispenses with the requirement that this Ordinance be read on two separate days and authorizes its passage upon one reading.



provide for safe retaining walls in Sycamore Township


