RESOLUTION 2013- 155

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN
AMBULANCE FROM THE OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM,
DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Sycamore Township is a participant in the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program which follows the bidding requirements for the purchase of fire equipment so that the Township is not required to obtain separate bids, and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to acquire a new ambulance for EMS purposes and the price for such a vehicle from Horton Emergency Vehicles, the low bidder under the Cooperative Purchasing Program, is \$224,500.00;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The President and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Horton Emergency Vehicles for the purchase of a 2014 Horton 623 Conversion Ambulance with a 2014 Navistar 4300LP chassis. The purchase price, subject to additions and deletions set forth therein, shall not exceed \$224,500.00.


SECTION 2. The Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, by at least a majority vote of all of its members, dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and authorizes its passage upon one reading.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety of the Sycamore Township. The reason for the emergency is to provide the necessary vehicle to the Sycamore Township EMS and Fire Department in a timely manner.






