

RESOLUTION 2014 - 21

**A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING NO PARKING ON AREAS OF
TOWNSHIP ROADS IN THE WINDFIELD SUBDIVISION IN SYCAMORE
TOWNSHIP, DISPENSING WITH SECOND READING, AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, in order to provide for safe streets and roads in Sycamore Township, Ohio;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. Due to indiscriminate parking and to insure the free movement of emergency vehicles on Autumnwind Drive, a dedicated road in Sycamore Township, there shall be no parking on the south side of Autumnwind Drive from the intersection of Autumnwind Drive and Stillwind Drive through and including the cul-de-sac.

SECTION 2. Due to indiscriminate parking and to insure the free movement of emergency vehicles on Timberbreak Drive, a dedicated road in Sycamore Township, there shall be no parking on the south side of Timberwind Drive from the intersection of Timberwind Drive and Stillwind Drive through and including the cul-de-sac.

SECTION 3. Due to indiscriminate parking and to insure the free movement of emergency vehicles on Bearcreek Drive, a dedicated road in Sycamore Township, there shall be no parking on the north side of Bearcreek Drive from the intersection of Bearcreek Drive and Stillwind Drive through and including the cul-de-sac.

SECTION 4. Due to indiscriminate parking and to insure the free movement of emergency vehicles on Fawncreek Drive, a dedicated road in Sycamore Township, there shall be no parking on the south side of Fawncreek Drive from the intersection of Fawncreek Drive and Stillwind Drive through and including the cul-de-sac.

SECTION 5. Due to indiscriminate parking and to insure the free movement of emergency vehicles on Buckland Drive, a dedicated road in Sycamore Township, there shall be no parking on the south side of Buckland Drive from the intersection of Buckland Drive and Stillwind Drive to the western terminus of Buckland Drive through and including the cul-de-sac.

SECTION 61.

Due to indiscriminate parking and to insure the free movement of emergency vehicles on Stillwind Drive, a dedicated road in Sycamore Township, there shall be no parking on the east and south sides of Stillwind Drive from a point 2,250 feet from the intersection of Stillwind Drive and Fields Ertel Road, travelling south and then west through the ninety degree turn to the terminus of Stillwind Drive through and including the cul-de-sac.

SECTION 7.

The Township Maintenance Department shall install the appropriate signage as required by law to enforce this Resolution.

SECTION 8.

The Trustees of Sycamore Township upon at least a majority vote do hereby dispense with any requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days, and hereby authorize the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

SECTION 9.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

SECTION 10.

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health, and welfare of the Township. The reason for the emergency is to provide for safe streets and roads in Sycamore Township and to allow the free movement of emergency vehicles.
