A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE STERLING RUN FARMS LIGHTING DISTRICT AND DISPENSING WITH SECOND READING

WHEREAS, the Sterling Run Farms Lighting District will expire on December 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 515, the Board of Township Trustees desires to continue the Sterling Run Farms Lighting District upon expiration of the contracts for the lighting district; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on continuing the lighting district was held on August 20, 2015, the required notice having first been given,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, Hamilton County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The Sterling Run Farms Lighting District shall be extended and continued for an additional ten years which district shall include the

following streets: Bridlemaker Lane, Quarterhorse Court, Startinggate Lane, Britesilks Lane, Derbyday Court, Trotterstrail Court, and

Silkyrider Court.

SECTION 2. The costs of such lighting district shall be assessed against each parcel

of real estate fronting on such streets at \$274.19 per parcel per year

bounding and abutting upon the streets so lighted.

SECTION 3. The assessment for such lighting shall be paid in ten equal annual

installments and shall be paid and collected in the same manner in which

taxes are paid and collected.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.

SECTION 5. By at least two thirds vote of the Board, any requirement that this

Resolution be read on two separate days is hereby waived.
