Whereas, Alzheimer's disease, a progressive neurodegenerative brain disorder, tragically robs individuals of their memories and leads to progressive mental and physical impairments; and

Whereas, an estimated 5.4 million Americans have Alzheimer's disease. More than 210,000 of those are individuals living in the State of Ohio; and

Whereas, Alzheimer's disease is the sixth leading cause of death in Ohio. This eventually fatal disease is a serious and growing threat to the health of our world; and

Whereas, the human cost of Alzheimer's disease is staggering. More than 15 million caregivers provided over 18.1 billion hours of unpaid care in 2015; and

Whereas, the annual cost to our country in total payments for healthcare, long-term care and hospice for people with Alzheimer's disease will cost \$236 billion in 2016; and

Whereas, in recognition of the individuals, families, friends and caregivers dealing with Alzheimer's disease, the researchers who are seeking a cause or cure; and

Whereas, Sycamore Township recognizes the efforts of Arden Courts Memory Care Community and the Alzheimer's Association to provide care, raise funds and promote awareness to fight Alzheimer's disease and related disorders, thereby improving the quality of human life for those living with Alzheimer's disease and their caregivers;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township that November 2016 is designated Alzheimer's Awareness Month in Sycamore Township, Ohio.
