NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1.

Resolutions 1995-14, 1998-36, 2003-61, 2005-17, 2007-10, 2007-85, 2009-15, 2009-22, 2010-17, 2011-08, 2011-16, 2012-04, and 2015-09 which previously established rates and fees for fire and EMS services are repealed in their entirety.

SECTION 2.

The rates and fees as set forth on the attached Exhibit A are hereby adopted as the rates and fees for services rendered by the Sycamore Township EMS & Fire Department.

SECTION 3.

The Trustees of Sycamore Township upon a unanimous vote do hereby dispense with any requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, and hereby authorize the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.

SECTION 4.

Upon the unanimous vote of the Board of Township Trustees, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of Sycamore Township and shall take effect immediately. The reason for the emergency is to provide for the timely provision of funding to the Sycamore Township EMS & Fire Department.

Failure to comply with Ohio Fire Codes on the 4th re-inspection there is a re-inspection fee due in the amount of \$200.00 and a notice to the building owner if different from the tenant and if no violations have been corrected.

Failure to comply with the Ohio Fire Codes on the 5th re-inspection there is a reinspection fee due in the amount of \$500.00 and a second notice to the building owner if different from the tenant. This fee will continue until all violations have been resolved.
