RESOLUTION NO. 2014 - 24

**A RESOLUTION RECONCILING APPROPRIATIONS, DISPENSING WITH THE
SECOND READING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, in order to reconcile appropriations for calendar year 2014; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1.

The Board hereby decreases the appropriation to the Kenwood Road Tax Increment Financing Fund by \$3,000,000.00 making the total appropriation to such fund \$4,933,237.00 for calendar year 2014.

SECTION 3.

The Trustees of Sycamore Township upon at least a majority vote do hereby dispense with any requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, and hereby authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.

SECTION 4.

Upon the unanimous vote of the Sycamore Township Trustees, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of Sycamore Township. The reason for the emergency is to provide for the immediate reconciliation of budgets and appropriations for calendar year 2014.




