PROCLAMATION IN RECOGNITION OF PANCREATIC CANCER AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS, November is **National Pancreatic Cancer Awareness Month**, which is an annual campaign to increase awareness of this disease; and

WHEREAS, in 2024, an estimated 66,440 people will be diagnosed with pancreatic cancer in the United States and 51,750 people will die from the disease; and

WHEREAS, pancreatic cancer is one of the deadliest cancers. It is currently the third leading cause of cancer deaths in the United States; and


WHEREAS, the 5-year relative survival rate for people diagnosed at all stages of this disease reached 13%. However, people diagnosed at the local stage have a 5-year survival rate of 44%; and

WHEREAS, the good health and well-being of the residents of Sycamore Township are enhanced as a direct result of increased awareness about pancreatic cancer and research into early detection, causes, and effective treatments.


