# Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Trustees of Sycamore Township Sycamore Township, Hamilton County, Ohio

Tuesday, April 18, 2023, 7:00 p.m.

The regular meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Schwegmann.

Present for the meeting were Chairman Schwegmann, Vice Chairman Weidman, Trustee James, Fiscal Officer Deters, Law Director Barbiere, Administrator Kellums, Superintendent Reutelshofer, Planning & Zoning Administrator Uckotter, Fire Chief Penny, and Lt. Tarr from the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office.

The invocation from Bethel Baptist Temple was read by Mr. Kellums.

#### Approval of the Apil 4, 2023, Trustee Meeting Minutes

The April 4, 2023, Trustee Meeting minutes were presented for approval. Mr. Weidman made a motion, seconded by Mr. James, to accept them. Mr. Deters called roll. Vote: Mr. James: Aye; Ms. Schwegmann: Aye; Mr. Weidman: Aye

## **Planning & Zoning Report**

Mr. Uckotter reported the Board of Zoning Appeals had heard two cases the previous evening. He said a request from Moeller High School to construct an addition was approved unanimously and a request by Cincinnati Hills Christian Academy to construct a new baseball field was approved unanimously with 16 conditions and four variances. He displayed a rendering of the field for the Board to view, noting that the field will be flipped toward facing Snider Road and that there will be state-of-the-art lighting and a very nice grandstand.

#### **Resolution – Zoning Case 2023-02Z**

The resolution "Approving a Rezoning from "F" Light Industrial to "DD" Planned Multi-Family S-PUD for the following Subject Property Parcels, 060001400200, 060001400011, 060001400012, 060001400014, 060001400017 for CIG Communities, LLC in Sycamore Township, Ohio 45242, and Dispensing with a Second Reading" was presented by Mr. Uckotter. Mr. Weidman made a motion to approve the resolution, seconded by Mr. James.

Mr. James stated the Board had a public hearing about this earlier, and it looks like a very nice project and a good use for the property.

Mr. Deters called roll. Vote: All Aye. Resolution 2023-026 passed this 18<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2023. **Sheriff Patrol Report** Lt. Tarr stated he had no report.

## **EMS/Fire Report**

Chief Penny reported the Fire Department completed the Medicare audit, and it was submitted and accepted.

# **Roads, Maintenance & Recreation Report**

Mr. Reutelshofer reported document shredding for residents only is Saturday, April 22, 2023 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. behind the Township Administration Building. He stated the South Trash Bash will take place Friday, April 28<sup>th</sup> from noon to 4:00 p.m. and Saturday, April 29<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at Bechtold Park.

Mr. Reutelshofer reported the Montgomery Road Sidewalk Project from Stewart Road to Ken Arbe is set to begin in mid-May and project information letters were mailed to abutting property owners.

Mr. Reutelshofer reported construction on the Gideon Lane Culvert Project is set to begin in July.

### Resolution - Authorizing a Contract with Carpenter Marty Transportation, Inc.

The resolution "Authorizing a Contract with Carpenter Marty Transportation, Inc. for Engineering Services for the Frane Lane & Marieview Court Culvert Project, Dispensing with a Second Reading and Declaring an Emergency" was presented by Mr. Reutelshofer. Mr. Weidman made a motion to approve the resolution.

Mr. Kellums stated he had spoken to the Board about this previously and had placed a map at each of their places so they could see the area involved.

Mr. James seconded the motion.

Mr. Deters called roll. Vote: All Aye. Resolution 2023-027 passed this 18<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2023.

Mr. Weidman asked Mr. Reutelshofer about utility work on Gideon Lane. He asked if Cincinnati Bell could work there now.

Mr. Reutelshofer answered they want to do the whole subdivision at the same time and are looking at September or October.

Mr. Barbiere stated he had no report.

### **Administrator Report**

Mr. Kellums reported asked for a motion to advertise for the Fiscal Officer Assistant position.

Mr. James made a motion to advertise for the Fiscal Officer Assistant position, seconded by Mr. Weidman. Mr. Deters called roll. Vote: All Aye.

Mr. Kellums noted the Annual Township Meeting will take place Thursday, April 27<sup>th</sup> at the Grove and he will RSVP for those who would like to attend.

Mr. Weidman added that is in conjunction with the Hamilton County Township Association Meeting. He said they do have a couple of agenda items. He said he thinks HCTA will hold another meeting with the Municipal League in June. Mr. Weidman and Mr. James both indicated they will attend on April 27<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Kellums said he has received a cost analysis from ODOT to put the Township logo on the chain link fence on the Snider Road overpass. He said the Township's share of the cost would be \$81,036.25. He asked the Board if they had any interest in this since they had previously decided a decorative fence would be too costly. The Board asked questions, discussed the proposal, and requested Mr. Kellums obtain a rendering of the chain link fence with the logos from ODOT.
